

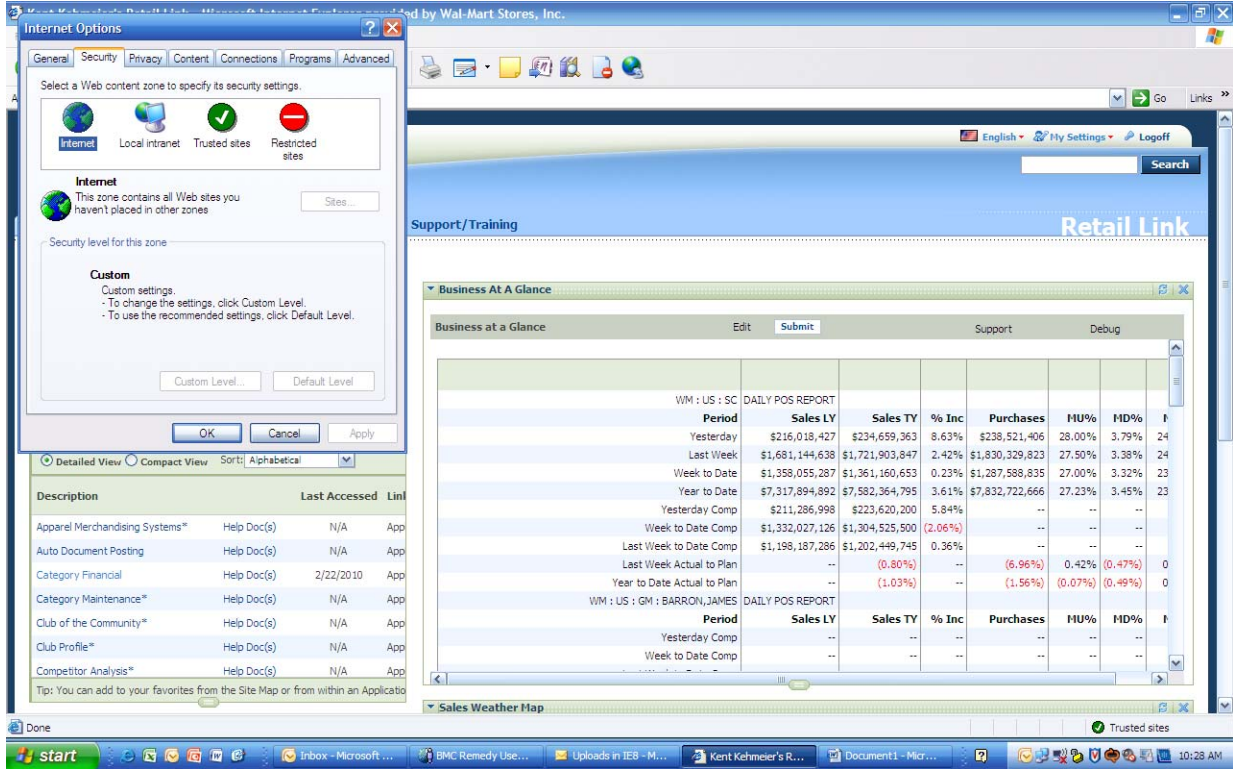
Open Internet Explorer and select Tools from the drop down menu, then Internet Options:

On the Internet Options pop up select the Security tab, then select Internet. Once you select Internet then select the Custom level button.



On the Internet Zone custom level, you need to select Enable under the heading Include local directory path when uploading files to a server. After this is selected you will need to save your selection.

Additionally, the "Include local directory path when uploading files" URLAction has been set to "Disable" for the Internet Zone. This change prevents leakage of potentially sensitive local file-system information to the Internet. For instance, rather than submitting the full path `C:\users\<username>\documents\secret\image.png`, Internet Explorer 8 will now submit only the filename `image.png`.

Further to this, I gave the following options to the customer:

1. Change the logic in the server-side code - It should not be dependent on the client-side file path location and should simply use the FileName property of the FileUpload control.
2. Enable the IE 8 option to include the local directory path for the Internet Zone on the client-side.
